Woodford County Considered for Television Documentary

PRINCETON, KY—Feb. 4, 2011—Award-winning film production company Marvo Entertainment Group LLC is considering Woodford County for inclusion in its *My Kentucky Home* documentary series. The series explores the history, achievements past and present, and hopes for the future of communities throughout the state.

If Woodford County is selected, the Marvo production team plans to spend 12-18 months on the project to create an in-depth look at the community and its stories. The program will showcase the county's history, arts, culture, tourism, preservation, economic development, business and educational institutions.

"Woodford County presents a tapestry of rich history, art and culture, a prevailing equine community, a rich landscape, and numerous stories waiting to be told," says Samuel Koltinsky, Marvo's Executive Producer. "The key component of a community documentary is the *partnership* with local people, leaders and schools to develop a project that is truly representative."

In the community, the project has been met with favor after Koltinsky presented his ideas to County Judge Executive John Coyle, Mayor Fred Siegelman of Versailles, and Mayor Tom Bozarth of Midway. In lieu of requesting public funds from the county judge's and mayors' offices, Koltinsky is seeking support for content and contacts. Numerous opportunities will be available for public and private funding support from the community for the two-hour documentary.

A Kentucky native, Koltinsky's work is inspired by a passion for stories, history, preservation, and the environment. Over the past 19 years, he has produced numerous documentaries in Europe and the United States, and has worked with PBS, the History Channel and the Documentary Channel. Upon returning to Kentucky after an absence of many years, Koltinsky created the *My Kentucky Home* series in response to the "wonderful, compelling" stories of its people.
