Woodford County in Preproduction for Two-Hour Television Documentary

PRINCETON, KY—March 18, 2011—Princeton, Kentucky-based film production company, Marvo Entertainment Group LLC, is in preproduction for "My Kentucky Home: Woodford County." The two-episode Woodford County documentary will be included in Marvo's award winning *My Kentucky Home* series airing on PBS affiliate KET. The series showcases Kentucky's rich history, fascinating people and contemporary treasures.

"We're very excited to have this opportunity from a historical standpoint," said Dona Wilson, Treasurer of the Woodford County Historical Society. "I'm hoping that when people see all that Woodford County has to offer, they'll want to come here."

Samuel Koltinsky, Marvo's Executive Producer is also excited about the project. "After continuing to research Woodford's history, speaking with some of its citizens, we felt it imperative to move forward on such a great county story. Partnering with the Woodford County Historical Society in concert with input from Woodford's citizens will allow us to leave the edit room with a two-hour show that will be a wonderful legacy to this county and its people," he said.
