

Gates calls for limited role aiding Libyan rebels

WASHINGTON (AP) — The U.S. should avoid developing a closer relationship with Libyan opposition forces, defense leaders said Thursday, telling an often hostile Congress that foreign nations must now take over airstrike responsibilities and any effort to train and equip the rebels.

With the U.S. role in Libya at a turning point, the next critical decision is how, if at all, the U.S. chooses to

support the opposition forces, particularly in the face of the ongoing budget crisis at home. Defense Secretary Robert Gates said he is opposed to arming the rebels, a step his boss President Barack Obama has not ruled out.

Gates and Adm. Mike Mullen, the chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff said it was time to turn the bulk of the conflict over to NATO.

Ex-Wildcat sentenced to 12 months in scam

LEXINGTON, Ky. (AP) — A former University of Kentucky basketball star has been sentenced to 12 months for taking money for basketball tickets that he didn't produce.

Ed Davender pleaded guilty to misdemeanor theft by deception in Fayette County Circuit Court in January. Judge Ernesto Scorsone sentenced him Thursday.

The sentence is to run concurrent-

ly with an eight-year prison sentence Davender began serving in September for a similar scam in which victims lost tens of thousands of dollars, the Lexington Herald-Leader reported.

Davender played for Kentucky from 1984 through 1988, scoring 1,637 career points, making him 11th on the school's all-time men's scoring list. He is fourth in career steals with 191.

*Receipts are not properly accounted for

*While May 19, 2010, total receipts agree with the deposit made, the receipt ledger didn't include an accurate breakdown of cash and checks

*A May 18, 2010, deposit showed that a check for \$70 from the inmate account was payable to and cashed by a jail employee

*The May 18, 2010, deposit also includes a rebate check cashed for a jail employee, an inmate's withdrawal check and a third party check payable to and cashed by a jail employee

*Four expenditures were found without supporting documentation, four checks were issued to a third party on behalf of inmates, invoices weren't properly canceled in five instances and the invoice was missing in one instance

*Auditors found a sheet from a receipt book with no other information was submitted as supporting documentation for a payment. A telephone message note served as a second piece of supporting documentation.

The report includes comments from Judge/Executive Pat White and Jailer Ken Mobley. White referred to the new internal controls training program the county developed. Mobley's comment indicates he agrees with auditors and that he found the recommendations

"helpful."

In a press release, both White and Gray said they were pleased with the results of the audit as it pertains to the fiscal court.

"For the third year in a row the Whitley County Fiscal Court has received

audits without negative comment," White said. "We are very proud of this significant accomplishment. To the best of our knowledge the fiscal court has never received three back-to-back-to-back audits clear of any notes, comments or findings."
